- Provide students with an ability to understand company stock markets
- Provide students with focus on analyzing companies financial needs in a global market place
- Give students a better understanding of the methods and systems used by managers to plan finance
- Provide students with an understanding of government financial needs
- Provide students with analytical skills for testing future finance requirements

Through completion of this course, students should demonstrate skill improvement in the following areas:

- Analytical skills;
- Problem-solving ability, including understanding financial and qualitative implications of international financial decisions.
